15,474 students


One campus: "Waterside"

2022 migrated from Sierra, Primo Classic and Talis Aspire to Alma, Primo VE and Leganto


Successful implementation; went live on 11th July 2022

How We're Structured - Big Picture









Key Vulnerabilities

Skill Distribution: Specific skill sets and knowledge residing in one individual; knowledge not distributed

Skill Acquisition: Technical and metadata skills honed over many years; complex skills which are difficult to acquire

Skill Lifespan: The age of our team; many possible retirements on the horizon

Cognitive Load: Small institution with a small team juggling a large cognitive load
